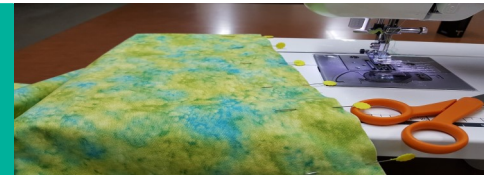


Introduction to Costume Skills

Aimed at

This course is aimed at post 16, school pupils studying GCSE and A level, students studying on existing creative courses or mature learners.

Course description & subjects covered

This short taster course aims to offer anyone interested in costume an introduction to the practicalities involved in interpreting a costume design by creating outcomes on a mannequin. Participants will gain some understanding of the skills involved in constructing a costume and the context in which it fits.

This course involves the following subjects:

- Introduction to subject area
- What is a costume? Interpretation of a costume design
- Basic pattern cutting and adaptation
- Pattern lay and cut, marking up cloth
- Basic costume construction techniques
- Finishing techniques and processes
