

# Connection to eduroam WiFi

**For students only.**

1. Connect to the **eduroam** WiFi network on your device.
2. Enter your **username** as follows:  
[username@cymoedd.ac.uk](#) (e.g. 123456@cymoedd.ac.uk)
3. Enter the **password** you have created for **Microsoft Office 365**.

You should have already received instructions from the college to login to Microsoft Office 365 and create a password, sent via email to your personal email address and texted to your phone.

4. You should now be **connected to eduroam**.
5. **Certificate issues:** if connection fails on your device or you get a warning about a certificate click "accept", "continue", "trust" or on a phone "Do not validate".

## Other information that you might need:

EAP method:	PEAP
Phase-2 authentication:	MSCHAPv2
<b>CA Certificate:</b>	<b>"none" or "Do not validate"</b>
Domain:	none, leave blank
Identity:	username@cymoedd.ac.uk
Anonymous identity:	none, leave blank
Password:	the same password you use to logon to Microsoft Office 365.

## If the above fails:

1. Check your username and password are correct by logging on to a college PC.
2. Restart the device, forget the eduroam network then try again.
3. Try installing the eduroam CAT app from the app store or Google play - <https://cat.eduroam.org/>
