It provides a facility for individuals working in the electrotechnical sector to develop and/or enhance their knowledge of the Requirements for Electrical Installation.

- EAL Level 3 Electrotechnical Qualification
- EAL Qualifications in Environmental Technology Systems
- EAL Level 3 Award in the In-Service Inspections and Testing of Electrical Equipment (PAT)
- EAL Level 4 Award in the Design and Verification of Electrical Installations
- EAL qualifications in inspection and testing

Assessment

This course is assessed through a 2 hour, 60 question exam.

Entry requirements

Learners must be at least 16 years old (must be 19+ to access through PLA funding). There are no formal entry requirements for the qualifications. However, learners must have the potential to achieve all aspects of the qualification. In particular, learners should be able to demonstrate that they have the minimum levels of literacy and numeracy required for the completion of the learning outcomes and the assessment.
