This qualification is suitable for electricians (and designers) who wish to gain an understanding of the requirements for electric vehicle charging equipment installations.

Course Details

Assessment

Entry requirements

Learners must be at least 18 years old. Learners must be conversant with the relevant wiring regulations, electrical installation and initial verification and commissioning. This can be demonstrated by the learner holding relevant qualifications in BS 7671 2018:2022, NVQ3 or ECS gold card and a level 3 award in inspection and testing such as the 2391-52. Learners must also have the minimum levels of literacy and numeracy to complete the learning outcomes and assessments.
