This course is aimed at post 16, school pupils studying GCSE and A level, students studying on existing creative courses or mature learners.

## Course Details and Content

This short taster course aims to offer anyone interested in costume an introduction to the practicalities involved in interpreting a costume design by creating outcomes on a mannequin. Participants will gain some understanding of the skills involved in constructing a bodice and the context in which it fits.

### Course Content:

- Introduction to subject area: what is a costume?
- Interpretation of a costume design
- Basic pattern cutting and adaptation
- Pattern lay and cut, marking up cloth
- Basic bodice construction techniques
- Piping
- Boning
- Eyelets and Binding
- Finishing techniques
- Photoshoot of garment
